With reference to your complaint against Dr. Satyam P. Singhal and his son Dr. Ashish Singhal, this is to inform you that the Disciplinary Committee of the Delhi Medical Council after examining the complaint and documents on record has concluded that the case against Dr. Satyam P. Singhal is to be referred to Ayurvedic Council for indulging into the practice of modern system of medicine without proper qualifications. The Committee has further directed Dr. Ashish Singhal that he will not write his degree "M.D. A.M." after the degree "M.B.,B.S." as it leads to wrong impression to the public that the doctor is M.D. which is not correct. The Delhi Medical Council has considered the findings of the Disciplinary Committee and concurs with their decision.
