Officer. went to Indraprastha Apollo Hospital New Delhi on 11 Mar 05 in the afternoon to look into the allegations of removal of both kidneys of one Ms. Maya Bhushan a ~~the~~ related kidney donor who underwent kidney donation to her son Vijaya Bhushan on 1.2.05 when a laproscopic donor nephrectomy was done by Dr. M.R. Rajashekhar of Apollo Hospital.

It was observed by the Committee that in a post mortem ultrasound scan of the deceased, the other kidney was present.

Efforts were made to interview the relatives of the deceased, who were however not available in the hospital at that moment.

Prima facie it appears that the allegation that second kidney of the donor Maya Bhushan has been removed by doctors of Apollo Hospital is not substantiated.

There is no complaint of medical negligence against the treating doctors hence no further enquiry action is suggested.

Hon'ble President has been briefed about the enquiry. To address the concern of the public at large media has been briefed as approved.
