3. To discuss cases of medical negligence and unethical conduct.

- (i) The Order of the Executive Committee in complaint No. 3293 of Dr. T.J. Hemnani, Dean, GS Medical College & Hospital, NH-24, Pilkhuwa, Distt-Hapur, U.P.-245304 addressed to District Magistrate, Hapur with copy to the Delhi Medical Council, alleging professional misconduct on the part of Dr. Ruhulla Hussain Dar, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.
- (ii) The Order of the Executive Committee in complaint No.3057 of Shri Satinder Singh Bhasin, D-24, Rajouri Garden, New Delhi-110027, alleging medical negligence on the part of Star Imaging and Path Lab Private Limited, 48/4, Tilak Nagar, New Delhi-110018, in the preparation/examination of lab report of the complainant, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.
- (iii) The Order of the Executive Committee in complaint No.3447 of Smt. Kamlesh Tuli w/o Late Shri A.C. Tuli, r/o Flat No. 25, Plot No. 31, Suruchi CGHS Apartments, Sector-10, Dwarka, New Delhi-110075 alleging medical negligence on the part of

- (v) The Order of the Executive Committee in complaint No.3732 of Shri Deepak Verma s/o Shri Ishwar Singh r/o RZ 46 P-Extention, Vishwas Park, Uttam Nagar, New Delhi-110059, alleging medical negligence on the part of doctors of Mahindru Hospital E-1, Kiran Garden, Main Najafgarh Road, Uttam Nagar, New Delhi-110059, in the treatment of complainant's wife Smt. Jyoti Verma, resulting in her death, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.
- (vi) The Order of the Executive Committee in complaint No.3666 of Ms. Mona Verma, r/o- GH-5 and 7, Flat No.42, Paschim Vihar, Meera Bagh, New Delhi-110087, alleging medical negligence on the part of doctors of Action Cancer Hospital, H-2/FC-34, A-4, Paschim Vihar, New Delhi-110063, in the treatment administered to complainant's mother Smt. Saroj Verma, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.
- (vii) The Order of the Executive Committee in complaint No.3652-a representation from Police Station, Dabri, Delhi, seeking medical opinion in respect of death of Smt Preeti w/o Shri Ajay Rathore allegedly due to medical negligence on the part of doctors of Dada Dev Matri Avum Shishu Chikitsalya, Dabri, Delhi, resulting in her death on 30.12.2017 at DDU Hospital, where she subsequently received treatment, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.
- (viii) The Order of the Executive Committee in complaint No.3424-a representation from Police Station, Seemapuri, Delhi, seeking medical opinion on a complaint of Shri Sachin, alleging medical negligence on the part of Dr. Deepti Aggrawal, Karuna Hospital, D-62, Dilshad Colony, Dellhi-110095, in the treatment administered to complainant's wife Smt Neetu, resulting in birth of still born baby at Karuna Hospital, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.

- (ix) The Order of the Executive Committee in complaint No.3584 of Shri Vijay Mathur, E-626, Raghubir Nagar, New Delhi-110027, alleging medical negligence on the part of doctors of Sri Balaji Action Medical Institute, A-4, Paschim Vihar, New Delhi-110063 in the treatment administered to complainant, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.
- (x) The Order of the Executive Committee in complaint No.3482 of Shri Rohit Ram, r/o- House No. 96/97, Sarai Kale Khan, Hazrat Nizamuddin, Delhi-110013, alleging medical negligence on the part of Dr. Deepanjali Talukdar, Dr. Ravinder Sabherwal, Dr. Avinder Sabherwal, Dr. Sudarshan Sabherwal and Jeewan Hospital and Nursing Home, Gate No.02, 150, Jeewan Nagar, Ashram, New Delhi-110014, in the treatment administered to complainant's daughter baby Shivanshi, resulting in her death on 13.03.2021, resulting in her death on 05.12.2018, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.
- (xi) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No. 3596- a representation from Police Station Sagarpur, seeking medical opinion on a complaint of Shri Jagpal Yadav r/o Village Rajokari, New Delhi, alleging medical negligence on the part of doctors of World Brain Centre Hospital Plot No. 24, Syndicate Enclave Raghu Nagar, Pankha Road, New Delhi-110045, in the treatment of Shri Deepak Vashist, resulting in his death on 16.4.2022, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.
- (xii) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No.2727- A representation from Police Station, North Rohini, Delhi, seeking medical opinion in respect of death of Smt. Goldy w/o Shri Pankaj Israni r/o- House No.C-4/173, Setor-06, Rohini, Delhi allegedly due to medical negligence in the treatment administered at Dr. Baba Saheb Ambedkar Hospital, Advait Clinic, Jaipur Golden Hospital, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.
- (xiii) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No.3703 -a representation from Police Station Keshav Puram Delhi, seeking medical opinion on a complaint of Shri Sanjeet Kumar s/o Late Shri Rajeshwer Prasad r/o H.No.1573/112, 3rd Floor, Ganesh Pura Tri Nagar, Delhi-110035, alleging medical negligence on the part of Dr. Santosh Kumar of Navjeevan Medical Centre (Dr. Bansal Hospital) Onkar Nagar-B, Tri Nagar, Delhi, in the treatment of complainant's son Master

Prateek Kumar, resulting in his death on 14.10.2022 at Sir Ganga Ram Hospital, where he was subsequently treated, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.

The Council also confirmed the punishment of removal of name of Dr. R.K. Bansal (Dr. Ram Kishan Bansal, Delhi Medical Council Registration No.942) for a period of 07 days awarded by the Disciplinary Committee.

The Council further observed that the Order directing the removal of name from the State Medical Register of Delhi Medical Council shall come into effect after 60 days from the date of the Order.

This observation is to be incorporated in the final Order to be issued. The Order of the Disciplinary Committee stands modified to this extent and the modified Order is confirmed.

The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No.1800- a matter wherein (xiv) it is noted that vide Order No.DMC/DC/F.14/ Comp.1800/2/2016/ 263554 to 263565 dated 18th July, 2017, in complaint No.1800, besides awarding warning to Dr. Sanjay Kumar Singh (Delhi Medical Council Registration No.36044) with a direction that Dr. Sanjay Kumar Singh should undergo fifteen hours of Continuing Medical Education (C.M.E.) on the subject Emergency Medical Care, the Delhi Medical Council has also indicted Dr. Rajesh Kumar and directed him to undergo CME. However, since at the time of passing of the aforementioned Order, Dr. Rajesh Kumar did not hold valid registration with Delhi Medical Council, as his name already stood deleted w.e.f. 5th August, 2007 under Delhi Medical Council registration No.15452, on account of non renewal; no punishment in terms of warning or suspension of registration was inflicted on Dr. Rajesh Kumar. It is also noted that subsequently, Dr. Rajesh Kumar had renewed his registration with Delhi Medical Council. In view of the fact that Dr. Rajesh Kumar had renewed his registration with Delhi Medical Council and the Delhi Medical Council in its Order dated 18th July, 2017 has indicted Dr. Rajesh Kumar, the Delhi Medical Council has initiated these proceedings against Dr. Rajesh Kumar, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.

The Council further confirmed the punishment of warning awarded by the Disciplinary Committee to Dr. Rajesh Kumar (Delhi Medical Council Delhi Medical Council Registration No.1542) with a direction that Dr. Rajesh Kumar

should undergo fifteen hours of Continuing Medical Education (C.M.E.) on the subject Emergency Medical Care, within a period of three months from the date of the Order and submit a compliance report to this effect to the Delhi Medical Council.

The Council further observed that the Order directing the issuance of warning shall come into effect after 60 days from the date of the Order.

This observation is to be incorporated in the final Order to be issued. The Order of the Disciplinary Committee stands modified to this extent and the modified Order is confirmed.

(xv) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No.3051 of Shri Rahul Jain H. No. 58/4, Ashok Nagar Ganaur, Distt. Sonepat-131101, alleging professional misconduct on the part of Shree Aggarsain Hospital Rohini in the treatment of complainant's grandfather Shri Sohanlal Jain at Shree Aggarsain Hospital Rohini, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.

The Council also confirmed the punishment of removal of name of Dr. Harkaran Singh (Delhi Medical Council Registration No.15817), Dr. Anurag Garg (Dr. Anurag Shamlal Garg, Delhi Medical Council Registration No.32814), Dr. Puneet Gulati (Delhi Medical Council Registration No.DMC/R/2339), Dr. Vipin Kumar (Delhi Medical Council Registration No.43491), Dr. Ashutosh Gupta (Delhi Medical Council Registration No.50528), Dr. Shruti Singh (Delhi Medical Council Registration No.23839), Dr. Himanshu Paliwal (Delhi Medical Council Registration No.55427) and Dr. Deep Kamal (Delhi Medical Council Registration No.10155) for a period of 07 days awarded by the Disciplinary Committee.

The Council further observed that the Order directing the removal of name from the State Medical Register of Delhi Medical Council shall come into effect after 60 days from the date of the Order.

This observation is to be incorporated in the final Order to be issued. The Order of the Disciplinary Committee stands modified to this extent and the modified Order is confirmed.

(xvi) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No.2624 of Smt. Nisha Rajouria, w/o Shri. Dinesh Kumar, r/o- House No. 26-A/Vrindavan Enclave,

Sahibabad, Ghaziabad-201005, alleging medical negligence on the part of Dr. Sangeeta Jain, Jain Hospital, Jgriti Enclave, Delhi and Dr. Sunil Kumar, City X-ray and Scan Clinic Pvt. Ltd, Tilak Nagar, Delhi in the treatment administered of complainant at Jain Hospital, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.

- (xvii) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No.2601-a representation from the Police Station Hari Nagar, seeking medical opinion on a complaint of Shri Rajenderpal Singh Rekhi r/o House No. WZ-262, 3rd Floor, Shiv Nagar, Gali No. 15, Jail Road, New Delhi-110058, alleging medical negligence on the part of doctors of DDU Hospital, in the treatment of complainant's son Master Abhijeet Singh, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.
- (xviii) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in the Judgment dated 25th November, 2022 of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in LPA 23/2018 matter titled 'Rashmi Dixit Versus Medical Council of India & ANR. (in respect of complaint No.1154 of Shri Gyan Deep Dixit c/o. Rashmi Dixit r/o. B-253, 3rd Floor, Mohan Garden, Uttam Nagar, New Delhi 110059, alleging medical negligence on the part of Dr. Madhu Chadda and Dr. V.S. Solanki of Amar Leela Hospital, in the treatment administered to complainant's wife Smt. Rashimi Dixit at Amar Leela Hospital, B-1/6, Janakpuri, Main Najafgarh Road, New Delhi 110058); in which the following issues have been raised viz. whether the treatment of fertility was prescribed by a qualified gynaecologist or a fertility expert; whether the problem that arose on 22nd May, 2013 were result of wrong diagnosis made on 04th May, 2013, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.

The Council further confirmed the punishment of warning awarded by the Disciplinary Committee to Dr. Madhu Chadha (Delhi Medical Council Registration No.57046).

The Council further observed that the Order directing the issuance of warning shall come into effect after 60 days from the date of the Order.

This observation is to be incorporated in the final Order to be issued. The Order of the Disciplinary Committee stands modified to this extent and the modified Order is confirmed.

(xix) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No.3715- a Court Order dated 11.10.2022,10.10.2022 in FIR No. 788/2022, PS Bh. Dairy, U/s 7/10

392/411/34/IPC, in the matter titled State Vs Ritesh @Gattu and Sandeep, passed by the Hon'ble Court of Metropolitan Magistrate-1, North Rohini Court, Delhi wherein it was directed to taking strict action against Dr. Deepak Kumar, Babu Jagjeevan Ram Hospital, Jahangir Puri, Delhi for preparing an MLC without proper examination of the accused persons, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.

- (xx) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No.2364 of Smt. Omvati w/o Late Devi Dass r/o 371/10, Tukmeer Pur Ext. Near Delhi Police Camp, Delhi-110094, alleging medical negligence on the part of the doctors of Dr. RML Trauma Centre in the treatment of complainant's son Shri Pradeep, resulting in his death on 30.10.2017 at Sir Ganga Ram Hospital, where he subsequently received treatment, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.
- (xxi) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No.2496 of Shri Shailendra Kumar s/o Late Sh. Yamuna Ram, r/o- House No. G-625-A, Phase VI, Arya Nagar Extension, New Delhi-110047, alleging medical negligence on the part of Dr. V. Bhatnagar, Dr. Ravi and All India Institute of Medical Sciences, in treatment administered to complainant's daughter baby Kashvi, resulting in her death 30.09.2016, was taken up for confirmation before the Delhi Medical Council.

Dr. Maneesh Singhal recused himself from the proceedings.

Whilst confirming the Order of the Disciplinary Committee, the Council observed that there is a serious shortcoming in the system where a patient was administered injectable (Midazolam) and trial of aspiration was done without getting admitted and involving the consultants of the unit. This lapse in adhering to protocol, led to unfortunate outcome. Hence, a warning be issued to the head of unit Dr. V. Bhatnagar (Dr. Veereshwar Bhatnagar, Delhi Medical Council Registration No.7242) for his lapse and professional conduct. Further, the Director, All India Institute of Medical Sciences is directed to make sure that credentials and the Delhi Medical Council's registration of the doctors should be thoroughly checked before employing them.

The Council also confirmed the punishment of removal of name of Dr. Sachit Anand (Delhi Medical Council Registration No.DMC/R/11616) for a period of 30 days awarded by the Disciplinary Committee.

The Council further observed that the Order directing the removal of name of Dr. Sachit Anand (Delhi Medical Council Registration No.DMC/R/11616) from the State Medical Register of Delhi Medical Council shall come into effect after 60 days from the date of the Order. Similarly, the Order directing the issuance of warning to Dr. V. Bhatnagar (Dr. Veereshwar Bhatnagar, Delhi Medical Council Registration No.7242) shall come into effect after 60 days from the date of the Order.

This observation is to be incorporated in the final Order to be issued. The Order of the Disciplinary Committee stands modified to this extent and the modified Order is confirmed.

 To discuss digitalization of the records of the Delhi Medical Council with regard to outsourcing of records.

Due to paucity of time, it was decided to take up this agenda in future meeting.

5. To discuss about the Minutes of the Anti Quackery Committee.

The Secretary informed that there are no minutes of the Anti-Quackery Committee of the Delhi Medical Council on which discussion is required, as no meeting of the Anti Quackery Committee of the Delhi Medical Council had been convened.

6. To discuss about the Minutes of the Finance Committee.

The minutes of the meeting of the Finance Committee of the Delhi Medical Council held on 02nd March, 2023, 13th March, 2023 and 20th March, 2023 (appended herewith as annexure 'B' Colly) which were circulated to the members present, were confirmed.

7. Any other item with permission of Chair.

(i) The Finance Committee of the Council recommended the contract for hiring of two taxis for Delhi Medical Council for the Financial Year, 2023-24 on monthly basis to Shalimar Tourist Taxi Service as their quotation is lowest.

However, the Council is not satisfied with the services of Shalimar Tourist Taxi Services due to condition of vehicle and driver. So, fresh tender should be called for hiring of two taxis for the Financial Year, 2023-24 on monthly basis for the Delhi Medical Council and

till the tender process is completed, the two taxis for the Delhi Medical Council on monthly basis may be hired from the existing travel Agency.
