# Minutes of the Council meeting of the Delhi Medical Council held on 09<sup>th</sup> January, 2020 in Conference Room of the Delhi Medical Council.

A meeting of the Delhi Medical Council was convened on 09<sup>th</sup> January, 2020 for 2.30 pm in Conference Room of the Delhi Medical Council.

The meeting was adjourned at 2.30 pm due to lack of quorum. The meeting was reconvened at 3.00 pm. The following were present:-

Dr. Narinder Pal Singh welcomed the members to the meeting.

The minutes of the Council meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> November, 2019 were circulated to all the members present, for information.

#### 2. Action taken report of minutes of the meeting held on 20th November, 2019.

Action taken reports, which were circulated to all the members present, were approved. The same are appended herewith as **Annexure 'A' (colly).** 

#### 3. To discuss cases of medical negligence and unethical conduct.

- (a) The Order of the Executive Committee in complaint No.2773 of Shri. Kunjumon Pappachan, r/o- Room No.110, Block G, Sector 20, Noida, Uttar Pradesh, alleging medical negligence on the part of doctors of Indraprastha Apollo Hospital, E-2, Sector-26, Noida-201301(UP) and Indraprastha Apollo Hospital, Sarita Vihar, Delhi-Mathura Road, New Delhi, in the treatment administered of complainant's wife wife Smt. Jisha Johan and her new born baby, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.
- (b) The Order of the Executive Committee in complaint No.2711 of Dr. Suman Lata Mendiratta Medical Superintendent Hindu Rao Hospital alleging professional misconduct on the part of Dr. R.N. Sahai, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.

Dr. Rani Kumar recused herself from the proceedings.

(c) The Order of the Executive Committee in complaint No.2839 of Shri Rajender Sachdeva s/o Shri Jung Bahadur r/o H.No. 9/6, Moti Nagar, Delhi forwarded by Dy. Commissioner of Police, West District, alleging medical negligence on the part of Khetarpal Hospital, Bali Nagar, Moti Nagar Delhi in the treatment administered to the complainant's aunt Smt. Pushpa Sachdeva, resulting in her death on 3.4.2019, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.

- (d) The Order of the Executive Committee in complaint No.2613 of Shri. S.R. Malhotra s/o Shri. Om Prakash Malhotra r/o Flat No. 200, Type C, Delhi Administration, Sindhora Kalan, Near Nav Bharti School, Ashok Vihar, Delhi-110052, forwarded by the Medical Council of India, alleging medical negligence on the part of Dr. Arvind Vaid, Dr. Swati and Indira IVF Hospital Pvt. Ltd, in treatment of complainant's wife Smt. Priyanka Malhotra, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.
- (e) The Order of the Executive Committee in complaint No.2913 of Dr. Puneet Kumar Mittal, House No.1498, Sector 16, Faridabad 121002, alleging medical negligence on the part of Dr. Rajiv Bajaj, Batra Hospital & Medical Research Centre, 1, Tughlakabad Institutional Area, Mehrauli, Badarpur Badarpur Road, New Delhi-110062, in the treatment administered to complainant's father Dr. Kanwar Sain Mittal, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.
- (f) The Order of the Executive Committee in complaint No.2806 of Shri Pramod Kumar, r/o- C-121, Hanuman Road, New Delhi-110001, alleging medical negligence on the part of Dr. L. Shyam Singh, GHS Maternity & Gynae Hospital, New Delhi, R.K Puram, Sector-V, New Delhi, in the treatment administered to complainant's wife Smt. Priyanka Kumari, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.
- (g) The Order of the Executive Committee in complaint No.2693 a reference from the Delhi Commission for Women, C-Block, II<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Vikas Bhawan, I.P. Estate, New Delhi-110002, forwarded by the office of Dy. Commissioner of Police, North West District, Ashok Vihar, Phase-I, Delhi-110052, seeking medical opinion in respect of death of 21 Children (who were suffering from Diptheria) at Maharishi Valmiki Hospital, GTB Nagar, Kingsway Camp, Delhi, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.
- (h) The Order of the Executive Committee in complaint No.2861 of Shri Hitesh Gola, H-15/B, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, Street #2, Shakarpur, Delhi-110092, alleging medical negligence and professional misconduct on the part of Dr. H.N. Bajaj of Max Smart Super Specialty Hospital, Saket, New Delhi-110017, in the treatment of complainant, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council

(i) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No.2612 - an intimation no.F.3/340/2005/DHS/NW/PNDT/4170 dated 1<sup>st</sup> November, 2018 from Dr. Satyendra Singh Dursawat DM/ DAA, Office of the District Appropriate Authority/District Magistrate (PC& PNDT Act), North West District, Kanjhawala, Delhi-110081, as per which Dr. Satish Kumar has been convicted under PC& PNDT Act in case titled District Magistrate-Cum, Appropriate Authority North West District Vs Dr. Satish Kumar owner of Kumar Medical & Maternity Centre AM-35, Shalimar Bagh, Delhi-110088, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.

The Council also confirmed the punishment of warning awarded by the Disciplinary Committee to Dr. Satish Kumar (Delhi Medical Council Registration No.1217)

- (j) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No.1963 of Shri Harsh Gupta, alleging medical negligence on the part of doctors of Max Super Specialty Hospital-East Block, Saket, New Delhi and All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Ansari Nagar, New Delhi, in the treatment administered to complainant's mother Smt. Anita Gupta, resulting in her death on 21.07.2016 at All India Institute of Medical Sciences, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.
- (k) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No.1865 of Shri Th. Mahendro Singh, alleging medical negligence on the part of Dr. Bhavna Ananad, Dr. Bandana Sodhi in the treatment administered to complainant's wife Smt. Th. Jenita Devi at Moolchand Hospital, Lajpat Nagar-III, New Delhi-110024, was taken up for confirmation before the Delhi Medical Council.

Whilst confirming the Order of the Disciplinary Committee; the Council observed that it is inconceiveable that the parents who have become aware of congenital defect, as it had happened in this case (Imphal USG report at 17 weeks 5 days) would not share the same with the gynaecologist or ultrasonologist. Be that as it may, the act of Dr. Bhavna Anand in not observing fetal limb abnormality in USG level-II (Anomaly Scan) done at 19 weeks, 3 days, reflects lack of exercise of skill, knowledge and care which was expected of a prudent doctor, as deformity of such gross nature at this gestation period, is

not expected to be missed, as limb finger ratio has to be documented at congenital anomaly scan at 18-20 weeks and level-II scan at 19/31<sup>st</sup> weeks, which apparently was not done, documented, hence, abnormality was missed. The fact that Dr. Bhavna Anand also missed the said deformity at 31 weeks of pregnancy, is evidence of the fact that she failed to exercise due diligence in conducting the USG test. In view of the same, the Council directed that the name of Dr. Bhavna Anand (Delhi Medical Council Registration No.36247) be removed from the State Medical Register of the Delhi Medical Council for a period of 30 days with a direction that she should undergo 30 hours of Continuing Medical Education (C.M.E.) on the subject of 'Level-II Fetal USG Scan' within a period of three months and submit a compliance report to this effect to the Delhi Medical Council.

The Council further observed that the Order directing the removal of name from the State Medical Register of Delhi Medical Council shall come into effect after 30 days from the date of the Order.

This observation is to be incorporated in the final Order to be issued. The Order of the Disciplinary Committee stands modified to this extent and the modified Order is confirmed.

(l) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No.2581- a representation from Police Station, Madhu Vihar, New Delhi, seeking medical opinion in respect of death of new born male fetus of Smt. Vimla w/o Shri Virender, allegedly due to medical negligence in the treatment administered at Manglam Hospital, B-42, West Vinod Nagar, Delhi-110092, was taken up for confirmation before the Delhi Medical Council.

Whilst confirming the Order of the Delhi Medical Council, the Council observed that in view of the fact that the patient had history of previous two LSCS, thus, at 36 weeks in labour, it was imperative that she should have been taken up for emergency LSCS, failing which, rupture uterus was the unfortunate consequence which ensued, compromising the well being of the fetus, as it happened in the present case. It is, thus, held that Dr. M.S. Chaudhry did not exercise reasonable degree of skill, care of knowledge in the management of the patient. The Council, therefore, directed that name of Dr. M.S. Chaudhry (Dr. Madhusudhan

Chaudhry, Delhi Medical Council Registration No.15174) be removed from State Medical Register of the Delhi Medical Council for a period of 30 days.

The Council further observed that the Order directing the removal of name from the State Medical Register of Delhi Medical Council shall come into effect after 30 days from the date of the Order.

This observation is to be incorporated in the final Order to be issued. The Order of the Disciplinary Committee stands modified to this extent and the modified Order is confirmed.

(m) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No.1928 of Smt. Monika Sharma, alleging medical negligence on the part of Dr. R.N. Saini and Dr. N.M. Aggarwal and B.L. Kapoor Super Specialty Hospital, Pusa Road, New Delhi-110005, in the treatment administered to the complainant's mother late Smt. Smt Raj Sharma at B.L. Kapoor Super Specialty Hospital, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.

The Council also confirmed the punishment of warning awarded by the Disciplinary Committee to Dr. Sunny Kalra (Delhi Medical Council Registration No.33060).

(n) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No.2644 of Shri Shabir, forwarded by Medical Council of India, alleging medical negligence on the part of Dr. Manish Kumar Gupta, Dr. Sandeep Kumar Saini of Jagpravesh Chand Hospital, Shastri Park, Delhi-110053, in the treatment administered to the complainant, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.

The Council also confirmed the punishment of warning awarded by the Disciplinary Committee to Dr. Manish Kumar Gupta (Delhi Medical Council Registration No.13426) and Dr. Sundeep Saini (Delhi Medical Council Registration No.19830).

(o) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No.2031- The matter pertaining to violation of the Delhi Medical Council's Order No.DMC/DC/F.14/ Comp.2031/2/2017/263473 to 263478 dated 14<sup>th</sup> July, 2017 in complaint No.2031, whereby Dr. Rakesh Kumar Bhatnagar was suspended from practising for the period 13<sup>th</sup> August, 2017 to 12<sup>th</sup> August, 2018, for issuing test report of Khadija National Hospital dated 10<sup>th</sup> December, 2017 and Arihant Path Lab dated 06.01.2018, was examined by the Delhi Medical Council, in terms of the Order F.No.V.11025/14/2017-MEP(Pt.III) dated September, 2019 of Government of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, was confirmed.

#### 4. To discuss about the Minutes of the Anti Quackery Committee.

The Secretary informed that there are no minutes of the Anti Quackery Committee of the Delhi Medical Council on which discussion is required, as no meeting of the Anti Quackery Committee of the Delhi Medical Council had been convened.

#### 5. To discuss about the Minutes of the Finance Committee.

The Secretary informed that there are no minutes of the Finance Committee of the Delhi Medical Council on which discussion is required, as no meeting of the Finance Committee of the Delhi Medical Council had been convened.

The Council directed that, if feasible monthly report of the finances of the Council be brought to the notice of the Council members, instead of practice of quarterly reports.

## 6. To discuss the development in space allotment at DMRC IT Park, Shastri Park, Metro Station.

- i) The Secretary informed the members about the progress in space allotment at DMRC IT Park, Shastri Park, Metro Station. The series of the meetings with the senior officials of PWD, Govt. of NCT of Delhi, regarding vetting of specifications of the estimate vetted from the point of view of economical construction, were convened.
- ii) Letter sent on 10.12.2019 to Er. Anil Kumar Ahuja, Additional Director General, PWD, Govt. of NCT of Delhi for specifications of the estimate vetted from the point of view of economical construction.
- iii) Letter received from Er. Anil Kumar Ahuja on 18.12.2019, stating therein the specifications are in order from the point of view of economical construction.

- iv) On 20.12.2019, the Land & Building Committee of the Council approved the publication of advertisement received from the Architect firm for inviting tenders for renovation of office space at DMCR, IT Park, Shastri Park Metro Station, New Delhi-110053 along with detailed schedule of tender.(copy enclosed)
- v) On 22.12.2019 the advertisement was published in English & Hindi Newspapers.
- vi) From 23.12.2019, the sale of tender form started from the office of the Council.
- vii) Till 08.01.2020 total 15 tenders forms were issued to different firms after receiving tender sale amount of Rs. 5,000/- by D.D.
- 7) Any other item with permission of Chair.
  - (a) Issue of Election of the Delhi Medical Council was taken up for consideration before the Delhi Medical Council.

It was informed by the Secretary that issue regarding the term of the present Council was discussed in the last Council meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> November, 2019. as is reflected in the minutes of the said meeting. In terms of the said minutes, a letter No.DMC/F.29/Elections/3/2019/286836 dated 28th November, 2019 was sent to the Pr. Secretary (H&FW), Department of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of NCT of Delhi for clarification regarding the term of the present Council. In this regard, a UO note Min.Health/2019/8149-51 dated 23<sup>rd</sup> December, 2019 has been received from the Hon'ble Minister of Health, Department of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of NCT of Delhi wherein it is stated that all proceedings of election of the Delhi Medical Council be kept on hold till said clarification along with all relevant files are submitted to the office of the Hon'ble Minister of Health, Department of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of NCT of Delhi. Subsequent to the letter, the Registrar met with the Pr. Secretary (H&FW), Department of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of NCT of Delhi, who verbally him told that this issue has been settled vide letter No.F.No.F.98/H&FW/2019/Council/1371 dated 13th November, 2019 and the Registrar may go ahead with the electoral process in accordance with the provisions of the Delhi Medical Council Act and Rules.

(b) The Council observed that since the Dean Faculty of Medicine Sciences has not been able to attend the meeting of the Executive Committee of the Delhi Medical Council, for quite some time, so in its place, The Director General of Health Services, Govt. of NCT of Delhi, may be invited to the Executive Committee, as elected, under the category (d) of the Rule 26 of the Delhi Medical Council Rules, 2003.

Meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.
