The minutes of the Council meeting held on 28th February, 2020 were circulated to all the members present, for information.

2. Action taken report of minutes of the meeting held on 28th February, 2020.

Action taken reports, which were circulated to all the members present, were approved. The same are appended herewith as **Annexure 'A'** (colly).

3. To discuss cases of medical negligence and unethical conduct.

- (a) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No.2899-A representation from Police Station Dwarka North, seeking medical opinion on a complaint of Smt. Poonam Mangal w/o Late Rajender Mangal r/o Flat No. 808, Sector-19 Akshardham Apts. Pocket-3, Dwarka, New Delhi-110075, alleging medical negligence on the part of doctors of Venkateshwar Hospital, Dwarka, in the treatment of complainant's husband Shri Rajender Mangal, resulting in his death on 30.11.201710084, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.
- The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No.3005- an e-(b) mail(subsequently received through post also) regarding an intimation F.no.283/4267 dated 14.1.2020 from Rahul Singh, IAS, Office of the District Magistrate/District/Appropriate Authority PC & PNDT ACT1994, (South West District) Old Terminal Tax Building, Kapashera, New Delhi-110037, as per which charges have been framed by learned Naveen Arora CMM/SW/Dwarka Courts New Delhi in CC no. 42/1 titled Nikhil Kumar Vs. Dr. Rajesh Birman vide Order dated 9.12.2013 under Section 23/25 PC PNDT Act against Dr. Rajesh Birman s/o Shri Munshi Ram r/o RZ-84, New Roshan Pura, Najafgarh-110043, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.

The Council also confirmed the punishment of suspension awarded by the Disciplinary Committee of the registration of Dr. Rajesh Birman (Delhi Medical Council Registration No.15712) from the State Medical Register of the Delhi Medical Council, till the criminal case against him is disposed-off.

(c) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No.2818 A representation from Police Station Sarai Rohila, seeking medical opinion in respect of death of Shri Rahul Kumar allegedly due to medical negligence in his treatment at Sharma Medical Centre, Shubdra Colony, Delhi, resulting in his death on 02.06.2019 at Maharaja Agrasen Hospital where he subsequently received treatment, was taken up for confirmation before the Delhi Medical Council.

Whilst confirming the decision of the Disciplinary Committee, the Council observed that in light of the gravity of the lapses committed by Dr. Suresh Kumar Abrol, the punishment of removal of name from the State Medical Register of the Delhi Medical Council for a period of seven days awarded by the Disciplinary Committee to Dr. Suresh Kumar Abrol, will not serve the interest of justice, hence, the Council directs that punishment awarded to Dr. Suresh Kumar Abrol be enhanced and name of Dr. Suresh Kumar Abrol (Delhi Medical Council Registration No.8677) be removed from State Medical Register of the Delhi Medical Council for a period of 30 days.

The Council further observed that the Order directing the removal of name from the State Medical Register of Delhi Medical Council shall come into effect after 30 days from the date of the Order.

This observation is to be incorporated in the final Order to be issued. The Order of the Disciplinary Committee stands modified to this extent and the modified Order is confirmed.

- (d) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No.2050- A representation from Dy. Commissioner of Police Central District Delhi, forwarded by the Govt. NCT of Delhi, seeking medical opinion on a complaint of Shri Raman Suri s/o Late Hari Ram Suri r/o D-20, Green Park, First Floor, New Delhi-110016, alleging medical negligence on the part of doctors of Jeewan Mala Hospital, 67/1, New Rohtak Road, Karol Bagh, New Delhi-110005, in the treatment administered to the complaint's father late Hari Ram Suri, resulting in his death on 22.08.2014, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.
- (e) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No.1987-A representation from Ms. Geeta Jotwani, Scientist "E" for Director General, Indian Council of Medical Research, wherein certain observation have been made against Dr. Udhav

Dorwal of Indian Brain and Spine Institute, Lajpat Nagar, New Delhi, was taken up for confirmation before the Delhi Medical Council.

Whilst confirming the decision of the Disciplinary Committee, the Council observed that in the facts and circumstances of this case, the punishment of removal of name of Dr. Udbhav Dorwal (Delhi Medical Council Registration No.42486) and Dr. Pawan Sharma (Dr. Pawantosh Vijay Prakash Sharma, Delhi Medical Council Registration No.18788) from the State Medical Register of the Delhi Medical Council for a period of six months awarded by the Disciplinary Committee was a bit harsh punishment and the same was not warranted. It was further observed that interests of justice will be served, if name of Dr. Udbhav Dorwal (Delhi Medical Council Registration No.42486) and Dr. Pawan Sharma (Dr. Pawantosh Vijay Prakash Sharma, Delhi Medical Council Registration No.18788) be removed from the State Medical Register of the Delhi Medical Council for a period of three months. The Council, therefore, directed that name of Dr. Udbhav Dorwal (Delhi Medical Council Registration No.42486) and Dr. Pawan Sharma (Dr. Pawantosh Vijay Prakash Sharma, Delhi Medical Council Registration No.18788) be removed from the State Medical Register of the Delhi Medical Council for a period of three months

The Council further observed that the Order directing the removal of name from the State Medical Register of Delhi Medical Council shall come into effect after 30 days from the date of the Order.

This observation is to be incorporated in the final Order to be issued. The Order of the Disciplinary Committee stands modified to this extent and the modified Order is confirmed.

(f) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No.1496 - A representation from Police Station Dabri, New Delhi, seeking medical opinion on a complaint of Smt. Chitra Tomar, Flat No.3/101, Bevarly Park, Plot No.-2, Dwarka, New Delhi-110075, alleging medical negligence on the part of doctors of Shri Dada Dev Matri Avum Shishu Chikitsalaya, Govt. of NCT of Delhi, Dabri, New Delhi-110045, in the treatment administered to the complaint Smt. Chitra Tomar at Shri Dada Dev Matri Avum Shishu Chikitsalaya, Govt. of NCT of Delhi, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.

- (g) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No.2564 of Dr. Nitin Kumar Parashar that an individual named Shri Nitin Kumar is impersonating himself as a Dr. Nitin Kumar by using the medical qualifications and Delhi Medical Council registration of Dr. Nitin Kumar Parashar and is employed with Swastik Hospital, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.
- (h) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No.2494- a representation no.F.23/Comp./76/NWD/DGHS /HQ /NH/ 2018/536 dated 14.06.2018 from the Directorate General of Health Services, seeking investigation into a complaint of Shri Uttam Chand Meena Manager (T), 17-D, Vikas Niketan, Pitampura, Delhi-110034, alleging medical negligence on the part of the doctors of Saroj Super Speciality Hospital, Madhuban Chowk, Rohini, Delhi-110085, in the treatment administered to the complainant's wife Mrs. Gargi Meena at Saroj Super Hospital, resulting in her death on 31.03.2018, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.

The Council also confirmed the punishment of warning awarded to Dr. Vivek Gupta (Delhi Medical Council Registration No.12973) and Dr. Greesh Manwani (Delhi Medical Council Registration No.3433) by the Disciplinary Committee.

The Council further confirmed the punishment of removal of name of Dr. Nisha Jain (Delhi Medical Council Registration No.12996) for a period of 30 days awarded by the Disciplinary Committee with a direction that she should undergo ten hours C.M.E. on the subject 'decision making and ethical practices in Gynecology' and to submit a compliance report to this effect to the Delhi Medical Council within a period of three months.

The Council further observed that the Order directing the removal of name from the State Medical Register of Delhi Medical Council shall come into effect after 30 days from the date of the Order.

This observation is to be incorporated in the final Order to be issued. The Order of the Disciplinary Committee stands modified to this extent and the modified Order is confirmed.

(i) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No.2249-A representation from the Police Station, Anand Vihar, seeking medical opinion on a complaint of Shri Saurabh Kalra, alleging medical negligence on the part of doctors of Jain Hospital, 177-178, Vikas Marg, Jagriti Enclave, Delhi in the treatment of complainant's father-in-law Shri Surinder Kumar, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.

- (j) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No.2810 of Smt. Anjali Gupta w/o Shri Neeraj Gupta, r/o- C-31/201 B, Kali Badi Marg, Gol Market, Delhi forwarded by the Delhi Commission for Women, alleging medical negligence on the part of doctors of Dr. RML Hospital, Connaught Place, New Delhi-110001, in the treatment administered to complainant's son Master Abhay Gupta, resulting in his death on 28.03.2019, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.
- (k) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No.2619-a representation from Dy. Commissioner of Police West District, seeing medical opinion on a complaint of Shri Anil Sharma, s/o Shri Durga Prasad, r/o House no. WZ-174, Mandir Wali Gali, Shadi Pur, Village, Patel Nagar, New Delhi-110008, alleging medical negligence on the part of National MRI-CT Scan & Diagnostic Centre Delhi A Unit of Hari Diagnostic Pvt. Ltd. No. 7, Arihant Nagar Metro Pillar No. 150, West Punjabi Bagh, New Delhi-110026, in the treatment of complainant's son Mr. Anshul, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.

The Council also confirmed the punishment of warning awarded to Dr. N.K. Sharma(Dr. Nand Kishore Sharma, Delhi Medical Council Registration No.25645) by the Disciplinary Committee with a direction that he should undergo three hours C.M.E. (Continuing Medical Education) on the subject of "MSK Radiology' and submit a compliance report to this effect to the Delhi Medical Council within a period of three months.

4. To discuss about the Minutes of the Anti Quackery Committee.

graduates are required to undergo one year internship before getting the permanent registration essentially for the following reasons:

- (a) To learn and gain clinical experience and exposure about the epidemiological and clinical profile of the country.
- (b) To learn and understand regional language, culture of local community; and
- (c) To learn and get exposure on the unique public health care delivery and referral system prevailing in the country.

Further, it is pointed out that, with the medical qualification acquired by the doctors they are not qualified to practice even in China, the country from where they acquired their medical degree one has to pass National Medical Licensing Examination (NMLE), which consists of a clinical skill test and general written test. It is also understood that all the medical graduates from China are returning to India without qualifying this test, which means the foreign graduates from China are not even qualified to practice in the said country.

The council after due deliberations has decided that the foreign medical graduates from China, Bangladesh, Mauritius, Philippines, Russia are, therefore, required to undergo one year internship before getting the permanent registration on the basis of facts above. The above decision is exempted for foreign medical graduates who have completed MBBS from Nepal and thereafter completed one year Internship from Nepal as Nepal has earned a high rank in the world for having top-notch medical institutions offering MBBS and other medical degree courses.
