

3. To discuss cases of medical negligence and unethical conduct.

(i) The Order of the Executive Committee in complaint No. 3528 of Shri Shankarlal s/o Radheyshyam r/o H.No. 722/5, Gali No. 5, Lakhpat Colony, Part-1, Mithapur, Badarpur, Delhi-110044 alleging medical negligence on the part of Shaily Gupta of Kishwana Charitable Eye & Medical Centre, in the treatment of complainant, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.

(ii) The Order of the Executive Committee in complaint No.3263 of Shri Bhushan Kumar Singhal, C-441, Saraswati Vihar, Delhi-110034, alleging professional

misconduct on the part of Dr. Subhash Gupta of Maharaja Agrasen Hospital, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.

Kashmiri Devi at RML Hospital and GTB Hospital, resulting in her death on 05.12.2018, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.
- (xi) The Order of the Executive Committee in complaint No.3626 of Ms. Jyoti Grover r/o M-170, Ground Floor, M Block, Greater Kailash Part-2, New Delhi-110048, Forwarded by the National Human Right Commission against Dr. Rajat Gupta of Rosewalk Healthcare, N-88, Panchsheel Marg, Block N, Panchsheel Park, New Delhi, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.
- (xii) The Order of the Executive Committee in complaint No.3119 of Dr. Aakriti Kapoor C-237, Vikas Puri, New Delhi-110018, alleging professional misconduct on the part of Dr. Abhinav Aggarwal A-1/237, 1st Floor, Janak Puri, New Delhi-110058, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.
- (xiii) The Order of the Executive Committee in complaint No.3572 of Shri Elahi Miyan, r/o- Quarter No.04, old compound, Bhagwandas Road, Mandi House, New Delhi-110001, alleging medical negligence on the part of doctors of Metro Hospital and Cancer Institute,21-22, Community Centre, Preet Vihar, Delhi-110092 and doctors of Kailash Hospital and Heart Institute, H-33, Sector 27, Noida-201301, in the treatment administered to complainant's son Mohd Arif, resulting in his death on 25.11.2021, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.
- (xiv) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No. 3635- representation from Special Cell/NDR, Lodhi Colony, New Delhi, alleging professional misconduct on the part of Dr. Hemant Tiwari issuing of medical certificate to one Shri Rambeer Shokeen, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.

The Council also confirmed the punishment of removal of name of Dr. Hemant Tiwari (Dr. Hemant Tewari, Delhi Medical Council Registration No.35837) from the State Medical Register of the Delhi Medical Council for a period of 365 days awarded by the Disciplinary Committee.

The Council further observed that the Order directing the removal of name from the State Medical Register of Delhi Medical Council shall come into effect after 60 days from the date of the Order.

This observation is to be incorporated in the final Order to be issued. The Order of the Disciplinary Committee stands modified to this extent and the modified Order is confirmed.

- (xv) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No.2701 of Shri Ramnarayan s/o Shri Shankar Lal r/o C-325, Budh Nagar Inderpuri, New Delhi-110012, alleging medical negligence on the part of Dr. Girish Tiwari, L-150A, Pipali Wali Gali, Metro Pillar No. 182, Shashtri Nagar, New Delhi-110052, in the treatment administered to the complainant, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.
- (xvi) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No.2960-an intimation File No.12/(5)DL/SD/PNDT/CC/2006-07/4918-21 dated 7.11.2019 from Ms. Harleen Kaur IAS, DM cum Appropriate Authority PC & PNDT (SED), Old Gargi College Building Lajpat Nagar IV, New Delhi-110024, as per which charges have been framed by learned Gomati Manocha ACMM/South East District New Delhi in CC No. 613428/2016 titled Dr. P.K. Bansal CDMO Vs. Dr. Sartaz Ahmed & Others, vide Order dated 30.5.2019 under Section 3 (1) read with Section 23 of the PC & PNDT (Prohibition of Sex Selection) Act, 1994 read with Section 4&5 of the MTP Act against Dr. Sandhya Gupta, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.

The Council also confirmed the punishment of suspension of registration of Dr. Sandhya Gupta (Delhi Medical Council Registration No. 3773) from the State Medical Register of the Delhi Medical Council in terms of mandate under Section 23(2) PC & PNDT Act, till the criminal case against her is disposed-off.

- (xvii) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No.3256-a representation from Police Station Barakhamba Road, New Delhi, seeking medical opinion in respect of death of Smt. Anita Shaw w/o Sh. L.B. Shaw, r/o G-614, Jahangir Puri, Delhi, allegedly due to medical negligence in the treatment administered at Delhi IVF Fertility Research Centre, Bengali Market, Opp. Nathu's Sweets, New Delhi-110001, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.

The Council further confirmed the punishment of warning awarded by the Disciplinary Committee to Dr. Anoop Gupta (Delhi Medical Council Registration No.8312) and Dr. Aastha Gupta (Dr. Aastha, Delhi Medical Council Registration No.DMC/R/7132).

The Council further observed that the Order directing the issuance of warning shall come into effect after 60 days from the date of the Order.

This observation is to be incorporated in the final Order to be issued. The Order of the Disciplinary Committee stands modified to this extent and the modified Order is confirmed.

- (xix) The Order of the Disciplinary Committee in complaint No.2682 of Smt. Nirupama Dutta r/o A 98/1 SFS Flats, Saket, New Delhi-110017, forwarded by the Medical Council of India, alleging medical negligence on the part of doctors of Max Hospital, Saket, Delhi, in the treatment administered to complainant's mother Smt. Kailash Puri,, was confirmed by the Delhi Medical Council.

4. To discuss about the Minutes of the Anti Quackery Committee.

The Secretary informed that there are no minutes of the Anti-Quackery Committee of the Delhi Medical Council on which discussion is required, as no meeting of the Anti Quackery Committee of the Delhi Medical Council had been convened.

The Council observed that an action plan for effectively and robustly to tackle the menace of quackery be formulated.

The President, Delhi Medical Council directed the Chairman, Anti-Quackery Committee of the Delhi Medical Council to take necessary steps in this regard.

5. To discuss about the Minutes of the Finance Committee.

The minutes of the meeting of the Finance Committee of the Delhi Medical Council held on 17th January, 2023 (**appended herewith as annexure 'B'**) which were circulated to the members present, were confirmed.

6. Any other item with permission of Chair.

(i) The Secretary informed that in terms of CRMI Regulations, 2021 & FMGL Regulations, 2021 regarding the allocation of seat to the Foreign Medical Graduates(FMGs) for internship at various medical colleges in Delhi, the Foreign Medical Graduates who are willing to undergo internship at various medical colleges in Delhi, are required to fill a Form for allotment of seat. Now, the said Form has been available as 'Google Form' on the website of the Delhi Medical Council, so that the candidate can access the same easily.

The Secretary further informed that the seat is allotted to those candidates who are selected in accordance with the criteria (available in the website of the Delhi Medical Council) as laid down by the Delhi Medical Council.

(ii) The Secretary informed that the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) has registered cases against various Foreign Medical Graduates (FMGs) who have obtained their primarily medical qualification from outside India and subsequently got registered with the Medical Council of India (now known as the National Medical Commission)/State Medical Councils on the basis of fake Screening Test Result (as conducted by the National Board of Examination). In this regard, the cases against the following doctors, who are registered with the Delhi Medical Council, are being investigated by the Central Bureau of Investigation.

(a) Dr. Mahmood Ahmad (DMC Registration No. DMC/R/18152).

The following are the events, as followed by the Delhi Medical Council for granting permanent registration No.DMC/R/18152 dated 19th September, 2017 with the Delhi Medical Council to Dr. Mahmood Ahmad.

The Secretary further informed the aforementioned doctors were granted registration with the Delhi Medical Council after completion of due process, as the case may be, i.e. confirmation/verification from the erstwhile Medical Council of India (now known as the National Medical Commission) as the National Board of Examination, National Medical Commission/State Medical Council, Board, Embassy. etc.,

The Secretary also informed that the necessary assistance/cooperation is being provided by the office of the Delhi Medical to the Central Bureau of Investigating.

- (iii) A letter F.No.F.109/H&FW/2020/Coucil/DPC/Pt.file 1541 dated 23rd January, 2023 from the Health & Family Welfare Department, Govt. of NCT of Delhi regarding the furnishing the name of one elected member from the Delhi Medical Council as per provision of Section 19(C) of the Pharmacy Act, 1948, was taken up for consideration before the Delhi Medical Council.

On perusal of the aforementioned letter from the Health & Family Welfare Department, Govt. of NCT of Delhi, the Council unanimously decided the name of Dr. Aswhini Dalmiya is nominated under Section 19 (C) of the Pharmacy Act, 1948.

Health & Family Welfare Department, Govt. of NCT of Delhi to be informed accordingly.

- (iv) The Secretary informed that the expenditure which is being incurred on shifting and storage of official records of the Delhi Medical Council, have been increasing on year to year. Presently, the expenditure which is incurring on storage of official records is rupees ten lakhs, which was rupees two lakhs in the year 2014-2015. The Secretary further informed that at present, there are 2000 boxes of storage. The necessary steps should be taken to decrease the said expenditure. So, there is need to digitalize the official record of the Delhi Medical Council.

The Council deliberated at length and decided that digitalization of records should be done at two options whether digitalization to be outsourced or to be done at the office of the Delhi Medical Council by employing the additional staff to be explored. The same is to be discussed in next Council meeting on agenda item.

- (v) The President Dr. Arun Gupta informed the members that the Delhi Medical Council will organize the Social Get Together in the month of February, 2023/March, 2023, depends on the availability of the venue of our choice.

It is decided that the Social Get Together should be held by mid March, 2023.
